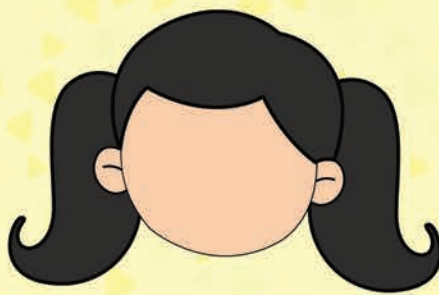

Cherry: "Then what would he do?"

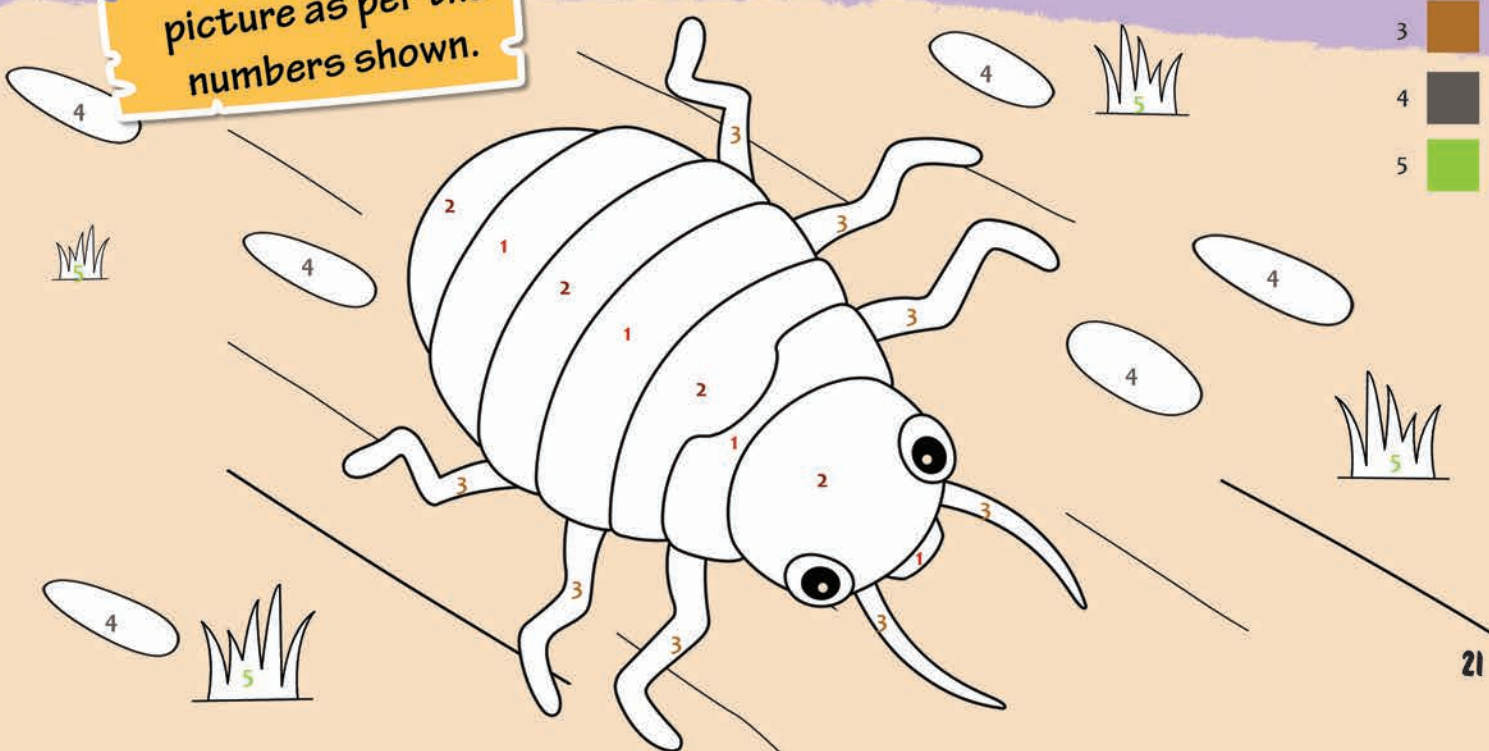
Mother: "Tell me, if someone hits you, then would you get hurt or not? Would you feel pain or not?"

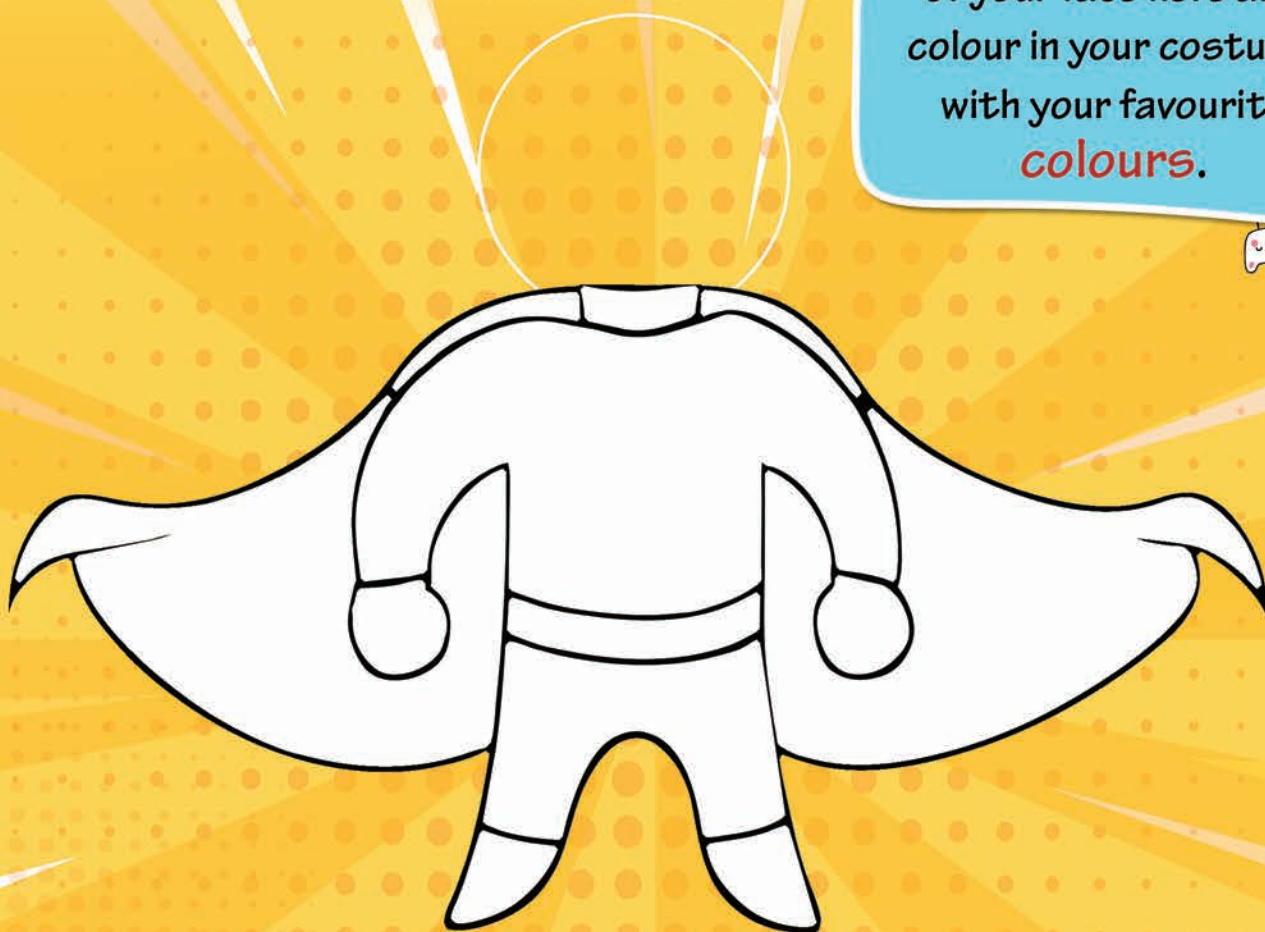
Chintu: "Now I understand why everyone called him a superhero."

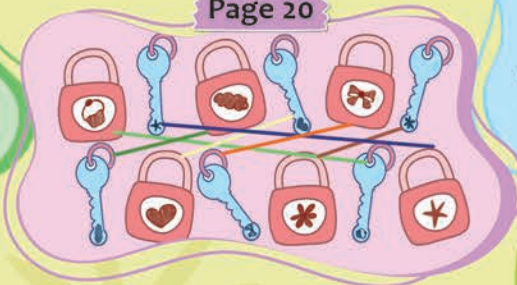

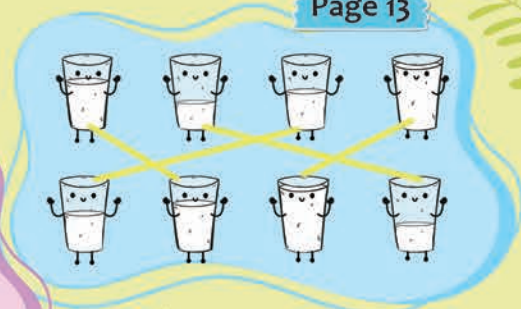

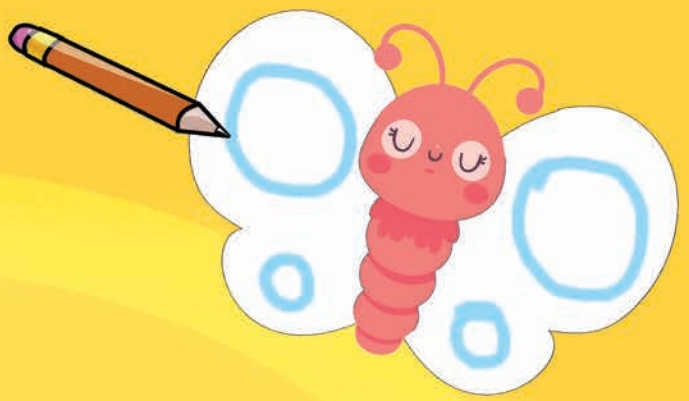
